TEMPO INTRODUCES NEW 802K DIGITAL LAN TRACING KIT

Kit offers tracing and troubleshooting solutions for LANs and other types of VDV wiring

Mesa, AZ September 10, 2007 — Tempo, a division of Greenlee, a Textron Inc. (NYSE: TXT) company, introduced its new 802K Digital LAN Tracing Kit, adding to its growing line of communication wiring tools. The 802K offers a powerful, exclusive troubleshooting and tracing solution for LANs and other types of VDV wiring. The industry standard 200FP filter probe is designed to eliminate hum from fluorescent lights and AC power wiring that can obscure tracing tones, and the AT8L LAN Toner not only generates multiple tracing tones and provides basic wiring tests, but indicates the presence of 10/100Base-T network service.

“We developed the 802K Digital LAN Tracing kit to give end-users a basic, but flexible kit of tools that can perform a wide range of basic wiring tests quickly and easily,” said Jim Carefoot, VDV product manager. “This particular kit can trace high-performance cables such as Category 5 and 6 and is immune to AC power noise. It can check for shorts, telephone service and working LAN jacks, too.”

The lightweight and durable 200FP filter probe features AC hum filtering; a bright LED for visual signal strength indication; selectable normal or filter operation and a blended carbon/plastic tip to reduce the risk of shorting terminals. There’s a powerful rear-fire speaker and an adjustable sensitivity/volume control to increase tracing accuracy. A continuous on button feature, low battery indicator; and a five-minute automatic shut off were developed for added convenience.

The 200FP filter probe has a slim, comfortable design and a recessed on/off push button to help avoid accidental power turn on as well as recessed tabs for butt set connection.

The AT8L LAN Toner integrates a number of useful features into one tool. Product features of special interest to those working with structured wiring include digital interaction with LAN hubs and switches LAN hub tracing with activity light blinking and LAN hub detection, splittable tone connections for tracking high performance Category 5 or 6 LAN Cable, a telephone service indicator, powered Ethernet check, selectable tracing tone sounds including Trace577™, 577 Hz/1000 Hz warble. There's also a low battery indicator for added convenience.
